

Treasure Map

1. Each person writes down Words of Knowledge in the spaces allowed for each category

- Location

- People's names

- People's appearances

- What they might need prayer for

- The unusual

2. Form groups of three (3) or four (4)

- Combine the Words of Knowledge from the group to make your "Treasure Map".
Note: Each member keeps their own list – **do not** combine lists on a separate sheet

3. Choose a beginning location (compare further hints while going there)

4. Start looking for the treasure!

5. When you find something on the Treasure Map (taken from the individual maps in the group)...
Approach the person.

- Say something like: "This may seem a little odd, but we're on a treasure hunt, and we think you're our treasure."
- Show them your lists (it may be one or two things from each list, or just one thing from one list).
- Build rapport (make friends – ask questions about them to get to know them).
- Let them know that God has highlighted them, and wants to bless them.
- Ask if you can pray for them (pay attention to things you could help them with).

6. If they say "no"

- Build more rapport (common ground - friendship).
- Ask the Holy Spirit what he wants to highlight about the person.
- Give them some encouraging words (prophecy), without being religious.

7. Ask again if you can pray for them.

- If they say "no", bless them and proceed to the next treasure (person).
- If they say "yes", pray for them (especially for healing)!
 - Ask for the presence of God to come (release His presence on their lives).
 - Command the pain to leave, bones to be set, tumours to shrink, proclaim the order of God's creation, etc.
 - Ask them to test it out: "Can you do something you couldn't do before we prayed?"
 - If necessary, repeat one more time/several times.

8. When they are healed or you have blessed them with prophetic words, ...

- Explain what just happened (the kindness of God revealed; "He knows you and cares about you." etc.).
- Ask them if they would like to know Jesus personally (have a relationship with Him).
- Have them ask Jesus into their life.

9. Go to the next Divine Appointment on the Treasure Map!

How to complete the Treasure Map

- 1.) Go to a quiet place.
- 2.) Distance yourself from all distracting thoughts and release the Kingdom of God over you.
- 3.) Ask for Words of Knowledge.
- 4.) Take a timer (mobile phone, stopwatch, egg timer) und set it for 5 minutes.
- 5.) Write down everything that comes to your mind – every single thing.
- 6.) Either write it down line by line, or whatever order you like.
- 7.) Fill in all spaces – the treasure map has to be filled in completely.
- 8.) Give thanks to the Lord for all those Words of Knowledge.
- 9.) Pray for the outreach and thank Him for the privilege of joining Him in building His Kingdom and destroying the works of the devil.

Explanations:

Going to a quiet place is the easiest way to hear from God. If you have more experience, you can also fill in the treasure map while riding da crowded train. If there are thoughts that plague or distract you (e.g. if there's an appointment that may not be forgot), take a piece of paper and briefly write it down. This will clear your mind. The timer is just meant to be for the beginning. When you have gained more experience, the timer can be left off. The purpose of time pressure is that there is no time to consider things, so that every single thing that comes to mind will be written down – even odd and “stupid” things! Ask for Words of Knowledge and believe that all that now “sputters” are Words of Knowledge. The treasure map should be completed, since that's the only way how there will be plenty of hints that can be presented to the treasure (once you've found the person and he/she is confronted with your Words of Knowledge). The more precise hints there are, the more flabbergasted the treasure will be!! If you cannot describe a hint with words, then draw it (e.g. you draw a number on a specific piece of clothing; a hairstyle, tower, house, statue ...). Prayers and proclamations are very important for the outreach.

Proclaim that:

- His kingdom may come and His will be done
- He builds His kingdom with our hands, our legs and our mouths
- We have the assignment, authority and power to destroy the works of the devil
- We will do even greater things than He did while on this earth (John 14,12)
- The blind see and the lame walk
- ...

His kingdom come, His will be done!
